July is off to a great start here at Credly! We have some exciting updates and a few previews to share with you this month.

Soft-launch of New Insights

We recently enhanced the Insights tab in the badge template area. This is a feature that will be updated and improved upon, and you may find it of interest as we develop the tool.

Using artificial intelligence to map credentials to labor market data and skills, we added information based on the *entirety* of the metadata on a badge. Our tool reads the description, criteria and skills tags, and maps to O*Net occupation families. On the Insights tab, we now list occupations, knowledge, skills and abilities that match your template.

We also tell you how confident we are in that match. For example, in the image below, we are 87% confident the template matches people in marketing occupations, and 99% confident that earners also have administration and management skills.

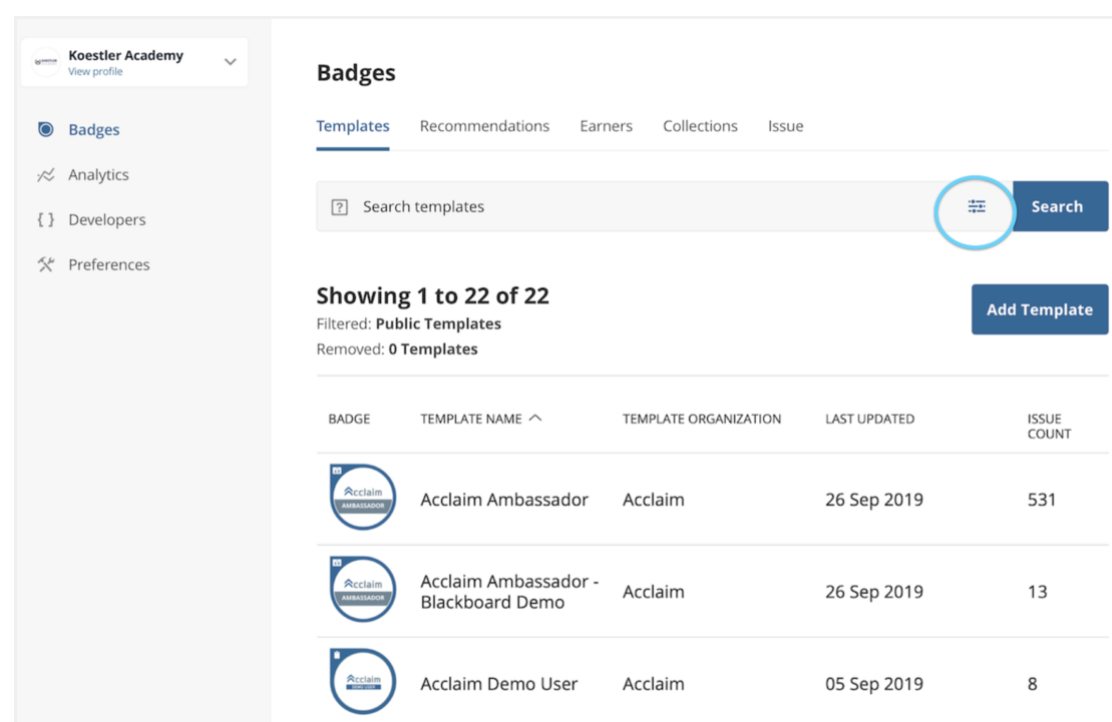

Keep an eye out for some exciting updates
